



VACANCY : ENFORCEMENT/QUALITY CONTROL SURVIVAL OFFICER (x1)

It operates six (6) forest stations: 4 based in Viti Levu & 2 based in Vanua Levu and provides employment to its "Pine Landowners" and hundreds of individual(s). It is the largest contributor towards the GDP from the forestry sector. We are looking for dynamic individual with suitable qualifications and experience for the position of **Enforcement/Quality Control/Survival Officer (x1)** to be based at our Bua Station.

Responsibilities

This will involve:

- Overseeing the use of FPL land for recreational and other purposes.
- Preserving FPL amenities such as roads, sites, and trails.
- Protecting threatened and endangered wildlife and vegetation.
- Assisting in preparing fire lines, and performing fire detection through ground patrol or tower staffing.
- Collecting tree seeds, lifting and planting of tree seedlings.
- Effectively organize and distribute fieldwork including; delineation of plots; record measurements; local contacts; access the sampling units; quality control of the overall unit of FPL operations.
- Measuring and controlling the quality of inventory of FPL operations to maintain data quality within an acceptable range.
- Collecting, maintaining and analysing data on forest fire and effectively carry out investigations.
- Conducting special surveillance operations and assist the forest law agencies when necessary during emergencies.
- Maintaining forest inventory by tree marking.
- Inspecting logging operations to ensure they are conducted in accordance with regulations designed to protect FPL forests and the environment.
- Monitoring and inspection of the logging crews for safety and operation compliance with FSC standard.
- Should be able to work on a 24/7 and assist the forest management team on required asking.
- Assisting in carrying out quality checks and survival assessments.
- Ensuring to reduce instances of trespassing, vandalism and solicitation and to be vigilant and prevent to prohibit dumping of hazardous waste in forests of Fiji Pine.
- Ensuring to compile, complete report and is submitted to superiors in timely manner.
- Ensuring to carryout housekeeping, maintain OHS as per standards and adhere to company policy and procedures at all times.
- Carrying out any other duties within scope of the position or as assigned by the department Manager from time to time.

Qualification & Experience

The successful candidate must have the following prerequisites:

- Diploma in Forestry or Agriculture with minimum of 3 years' relevant experience

work experience in field sector.

- Knowledge of fire laws and regulations.
- Physically fit and strong, with sound navigational skills.
- Good computer knowledge skills.

- Must have a valid clear Group 2 Driving license.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Positive attitude and a team player.
- Be physically fit.
- Flexible attitude towards working hours.
